Nomination for an Exchange Student at the HAW Hamburg:	The coordinators need to nominate their student via our online application system "Mobility Online". The nomination link will be sent to all partner universities at the start of the application period (March and September). As there might be changes in the application process from one semester to the next students can get nominated only for one semester in advance. We kindly request to nominate students in strict accordance with the departments defined in the existing partnership agreements.
Application Period:	For Winter Semester: March 1 – April 30 For Summer Semester: September 1 – October 30
Application for an Exchange Student at the HAW Hamburg:	The nominated students will automatically receive a registration link by eMail to upload the required documents (see below) and complete their application in "Mobility Online".
